To Behaviormetrika authors,

Currently, the Editing Committee for the English Journal of the Behaviormetric Society of Japan is planning to make available on the Internet in digital format articles that have been published in Behaviormetrika. This plan is connected to the digital archiving program for academic journals sponsored by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports and Technology. Articles converted to digital format will be freely accessible on the J-Stage publishing website by the Japan Science and Technology Agency.

From Vol. 27, No. 2 (2000) of Behaviormetrika and on, authors signed a copyright transfer statement at the time their papers were published. However, from Vol. 27, No. 1 (2000) and before, the Behaviormetric Society of Japan did not receive such clear approval related to copyright transfer from authors. From November 2005, the BSJ has been sending out copyright transfer statements to all authors who have not yet given copyright transfer approval. Unfortunately, our editing committee still has a list of authors whose contact addresses or approval could not be verified. A list of research papers from authors we have not been able to contact before March 20, 2006 has been published on the following website.
